

Bowling association seeks hall of fame nominations

The Greater Calumet Area USBC is looking for men and women who have had an impact on the local bowling community for its inaugural Hall of Fame.

In August, the Greater Calumet Area USBC Bowling Association and the Calumet Women's USBC merged and became the Greater Calumet Area USBC. Both organizations, representing league bowlers from centers in Dyer, Griffith, Highland, Hammond and Whiting in Indiana and Calumet City, Lansing and Lynwood in Illinois, had respective halls of fame. Those inducted in 2012 will be the first class of the new, merged group.

Nominees should be at least 45 years of age and have been sanctioned league bowlers in GCA centers for at least 10 years. Hall of fame applications can be found on the Hall of Fame page of the GCA website, www.greatercalumet.com.

Nomination deadline is June 1. The GCA Hall of Fame committee will vet the nominations, which will then be voted on by GCABA and Calumet Women's hall of famers and the GCA Board of Directors. Winners will be honored at the 26th annual Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet in December.
