

Graduating high school senior boys who bowl in youth leagues at Greater Calumet Area USBC Bowling Association centers are eligible to compete for \$1,000 or more in scholarships offered by the bowling association.

Representing more than 4,500 adult bowlers in bowling centers from Dyer to Whiting to Calumet City to Lynwood, the GCABA rewards boys who have excelled in the classroom and participated in youth leagues.

Scholarship forms are available through youth league coaches or by calling the GCABA office at (219) 923-7240. The deadline to return the forms is June 1.

While the GCABA budgets \$1,000 each year, the award is augmented with the proceeds from the annual Scholarship Golf Outing. Last year, four boys split \$1,500.

The goal this year is to bring in an additional \$1,000 through \$50 hole sponsorships and prize donations. The 2011 golf outing is July 23 at Wicker Park in Highland. It is a four-person scramble format.
