## League tools are now available for mobile devices

The USBC Playing Rules and Commonly Asked Questions now can be downloaded to mobile devices. Click [here](#) to learn how you can have the Rulebook available whenever you need it.

## You can now download the League Certification Application

Another new downloadable tool is the League Certification Application. Click [here](#) for the application, which also can be found under the League tab on [BOWL.com](http://BOWL.com) and on the Rules page under League Resources, and can be used in place of the printed form. Numbers will be assigned by the association or processor.

Associations will enter the league application number by using the Association's Charter number plus a sequential number of the association's choosing. For example, Abbotsford USBC, Association #80248, would enter the league application number as 802481 or it could be 8024810.

Center processors will enter the center certification number plus a sequential number of the center's choosing. For example, Forum Bowl, center certification #1257, would enter the league application number as 1257100 or it could be 125710.

The application includes a President's Monthly Verification Worksheet, complete instructions, application and league dues worksheet. Complete and provide a signed application along with membership application cards and the appropriate membership fees to your local association manager or league processor.
